A Personal Advisor (PA for short) is someone from the local Authority that works with you when you reach the age of 16. They will work with you until the age of 25 if you want them to.

HOW OFTEN WILL MY PERSONAL ADVISOR BE IN TOUCH?

Your Personal Advisor has to be in contact at least once every 8 weeks but will discuss how often you would like to be in contact with them whether its over the phone, texts, email or face to face.

WHERE ARE PERSONAL ADVISORS?

Personal Advisors are based in Wallasey, Rock Ferry and Pensby in the social care offices. But they will come see you were ever you live in Great Britain.

WHAT WILL YOUR PERSONAL ADVISOR SUPPORT YOU WITH?

Personal Advisors will try help you with anything that you want. This includes your pathway plan and your entitlements (see pathway plan/entitlements leaflet for more information).
